

# CHURCH CALENDAR - LECTIONARY





Worship is the heartbeat of the church an occasion for thanks giving and an opportunity to offer our gratitude for God's redemptive intervention in history. The worshipping community ardently remembers God's salvific act in the their life. Worship is a celebration of faith and gives new strength to the church that experiences the power of both Jesus sacrificial love displayed on the cross and the resurrection. The word became flesh and dwelt- and worked among us with truth and grace so that the kingdom of God is realised and God's will revealed. Through worship, God's love is conveyed and the Church is equipped and inspired for Christian witness. In worship, we receive the Spiritual and Moral Strength to view life through Christs' perspective and refine our paths. Worship deepens our understanding of God, Selt, and the realities of society. Worship is a service. The word Liturgy is derived from the Greek term *Leitourgia* which means service.
